3	<b>Materow ow sordya / Matters arising</b> Parkvedras Terrace, Truro = <b>Terras Park Karvodres</b>  Amended from "Parkarvodres" to help make the elements clearer.

5	<b>Arwodhow yn stretow / Street signs</b> Hillside View, Lostwithiel = <b>Gwel an Mena</b>	
6	<b>Henwyn tyller / Placenames</b> Black Carn (SW360222) = <b>Pedn Du</b>  Carkease Cliff (SW401224) = <b>Als Karkeys</b>  Located on Cribba Head. May contain <kar> and <ke> 'hedge'.  Extant remains of a stone structure recorded at Cribba Head

	Carn Barra = DEFERRED	
	Deferred for further research to determine whether the element could be <bara> 'loaf' due to its shape as a coastal mark. An alternative meaning was <barrow> 'summits'.	
	Carn Base (SW309197) = <b>Karn Bas</b>	
	Containing <karn> 'carn' and <bas> 'shallow'.	
	It is a rocky shoal, with a depth of 9.9m, lies about 2 miles S of Longships, near the W edge of a bank. (source: <a href="https://www.govinfo.gov/">https://www.govinfo.gov/</a> )	
	Carn Guthensbras (SW364217) = <b>Karn Kudhen Vras</b>	
	Containing <kudhen> 'hidden place' + <bras> 'large'.	
	Carn Boel = <b>Karn Bool</b>	
	Weatherhill suggests "axe-shaped crag" for Carn Boel.	
	Carn Lês Boel (SW355232) = <b>Karn Les Bool</b>	
	A cliff castle located on the opposite side of Mill Bay (Nanjizal) from Carn Boel. Possibly <les-> 'false', as in <lesvroder> 'step-brother'.	
	Carn Mellyn (SW449237) = <b>Karn Melyn</b>	
	Located on west side of Lamorna Cove. Thought to contain <melyn> 'yellow'.	
	Carn Scathe (SW373216) = <b>Karn Skath</b>	
	Carn Stone = OMITTED	
	One mention notes the following: It is only a few metres in extent but the Lee Mean rock, awash at low water, lies 100 metres eastward of the Runnel and the Carn Stone, with 2.2 metres over it, 200 metres northwest.	
	The exact location wasn't identified.	
	Runnel Stone = <b>Men Fros</b>	

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	<p>Chair Ladder = <b>Golva Harry an Lader</b></p> <p>Recorded historically as "Tutton Harry an Lader" c1680. The "tutton" may be 1700 thieves cant from Middle English <i>tuten</i> 'to peep, peer' (source: egwwritings.org). There are also was also similar words for a "toting-hill" and "tote-hill", which is an observation place; see: Warbarrow Tout, Dorset.</p> <p>Chyanhor (SW381245) = <b>Chi an Hordh</b></p> <p>There is an unnamed house and garden on the St Levan tithe apportionment (plot 95). Based on the location of nearby fieldnames "Chyanhor Field" and "Chyanhor Downs", this may be the location of the Chyanhor.</p> <p>Trebehor = <b>Trebugher</b></p> <p>The settlement of Trebehor is first recorded in 1284 when it is spelt "Trebuer". This would imply the term &lt;bugher&gt;, an alternative term similar to &lt;bughwas&gt; 'cowboy'.</p> <p>Gamper (SW345256) = <b>An Gemper</b></p> <p>May be related to &lt;kemper&gt;, a 'meeting of currents'. There would be eddies expected at these locations due to the streams. The historical "Gamper Sees" c.1880 could be referring to the joining streams.</p> <p>It appears to be the name for the entire bay area at Sennen and St Levan.</p>
